## **Preface**

This study was prepared considering the proposal offered in our September issue of 2014 (*J Pediatr Inf 2014; 8: 1-6.*) and also the suggestions of pediatric infectious disease specialists of our country. We would like to thank all authors and all pediatric infectious disease specialists for their efforts in this study, which we believe it will be a useful reference for the pediatricians and other physicians dealing with vaccines.
